

## Request for LCS Association Membership

The following persons are members of the LCS Association:

1. All parents and guardians of the children attending Lansing Christian School.
2. All regularly scheduled full and part-time employees of Lansing Christian School who have signed the Doctrinal Statement.

The following persons may also become members of the Association:

All interested members of the Christian community who have been approved by the School Board – based on both time and financial commitments to the school, a signed copy of the Doctrinal Statement on file in the Superintendent's office and a written request. (Article V of the Constitution of Lansing Christian School)

The Lansing Christian School Board will accept applications from individuals requesting consideration for Association Membership in accordance to the following guidelines.

1. Applications for Association membership will be accepted by the Superintendent's office twice a year during the months of **January** and **July**.
2. Applications must include a complete Request for Association Membership form and a signed Doctrinal Statement.
3. Applications are considered for individual membership only. A couple or family may request membership consideration but must complete individual information and signed Doctrinal Statements.
4. Applicants will be required to provide information regarding their personal involvement in the LCS community and the nature of their ongoing commitment to support LCS through gifts of time, talents and financial contribution.
5. Applications will be reviewed by the LCS Board in the month following receipt of the application. January applications will be reviewed at the **February meeting**. July applications will be reviewed at the **August meeting**.
6. Membership is determined by approval of the Board. Applicants will be informed in writing of the Board's decision regarding their individual application by the end of the month following Board review (last day of February for January applications; last day of October for September applications).
7. Full Association meetings occur in May and November of each year. All community Association members are strongly encouraged to attend.
8. Community members of the LCS Association have the privilege and responsibility to vote on matters of concern to the Association including approval of the annual LCS Budget in November and election of Board members in May..
9. The LCS Board reviews and updates the Association Membership list annually at the August Board meeting. Materials for continuing or discontinuing Community membership will be sent out to all Community Association members prior to that meeting.
