Elementary students applying for scholarships will complete the application and submit it to the LCS Main Office by **June 15, 2010**. Students should submit a 100 word essay to establish their qualifications and submit a teacher recommendation by June 15th.

 - Student demonstrates a positive relationship with teachers and students.
 - Student demonstrates evidence of positive leadership and contribution in the classroom, school, church, and community.
