

Career/Technical Center

The Career/Technical Center will be offering courses in a great variety of vocational programs during the school year. The aim of a vocational program is to prepare a student with job-entry skills in a vocational area. Students are currently being enrolled on a first come, first serve basis.

All Technical Center courses are 2 1/4 hours in length and carry three credits per year. Most of the programs are two-year courses and a student desiring to attend the Technical Center will take these programs during their junior and senior years.

If a student desires to be considered a Lansing Christian Student and graduate with a Lansing Christian School diploma as well as participate in sports, retreats, testing and trips, they may enroll in a career center and participate at Lansing Christian School for the core courses with administration's approval. The tuition for these students will be 80% of the full tuition.

If the student desires, they can be registered as a Home Schooled student. In this case classes can be purchased at the Home School set prices. In the case of a class that is at maximum size, an LCS student will be given priority over the Home Schooled student for space in that class. A Home School student is not tracked by LCS and not eligible for sports and trips and retreats. In addition, the Home School Student is responsible for class fees as applicable for a course.

DUAL ENROLLMENT

The dual enrollment program is intended to give high school seniors and juniors an opportunity to get a controlled exposure to college life during their junior or senior year. It is not designed to serve as an alternative to the courses offered by Lansing Christian High School or to be used to allow students an early graduation.

Guidelines: Juniors and Seniors with a GPA of 3.0 or higher, reimbursement will be for courses taken only during the student's senior year, one college class per semester. All seniors must maintain five classes per semester during their senior year and at least four of them taken here.

Reimbursement: Reimbursement will be limited to the lesser of \$500 a year (\$250 a semester) or 50% of the actual cost for college tuition, calculated on a semester basis. The reimbursement may not be used to cover fees other than tuition. The individual's tuition bill must be current and paid in full before reimbursement. Reimbursement will be made at the end of the course and will not be paid for C+ and lower grades.

Course Limitations: The post secondary course must be academic and may not be in the subject matter of hobby, craft or physical education. The course must be a course not offered by LCS or, if offered, is not available to the pupil due to a scheduling conflict and the student must have exhausted all AP and Honor classes in that area at Lansing Christian School. This reimbursement is not available for foreign exchange students.
