

## LCS Cultivation of Excellence Scholarships

The Lansing Christian School Scholarship Program for the Cultivation of Excellence enables secondary students to apply annually based upon their qualities and abilities. ***Financial need will be considered (parents must file by June 15, 2010 with FACTS*** (<https://www.factstuitionaid.com/facts/gaindex>). Scholarships will be prorated throughout the school year.

**Secondary students** applying for scholarships will complete the application and submit it to the LCS Main Office by **June 15, 2010**. Students should indicate which area(s) they are applying for, submit a 200 word essay to establish their qualifications, and submit a teacher recommendation by June 15<sup>th</sup>. Secondary students must possess a GPA 3.0 or higher.

- **Scholarship for the Cultivation of Excellence in:**
  - **Performing Arts** (instrumental or voice):
    - Student currently performing in music group(s).
    - Student demonstrates abilities in performing arts.
    - Student demonstrates evidence of positive leadership and contribution in the classroom, school, church, and community.
  - **Visual Arts:**
    - Student demonstrates abilities in the visual arts.
    - Student has contributed artwork to at least one non-LCS art event.
    - Student demonstrates evidence of positive leadership and contribution in the classroom, school, church, and community.
  - **Math:**
    - Student demonstrates an ability and interest in Mathematics.
    - Student demonstrates evidence of positive leadership and contribution in the classroom, school, church, and community.
  - **Science:**
    - Student demonstrates an ability and interest in Science.
    - Student demonstrates evidence of positive leadership and contribution in the classroom, school, church, and community.
  - **Writing:**
    - Student demonstrates excellence in his/her writing ability.
    - Student demonstrates evidence of positive leadership and contribution in the classroom, school, church, and community.
  - **Citizenship & Christian Service:**
    - Student demonstrates evidence of having a servant's heart and compassion for others.
    - Student demonstrates a positive relationship with teachers and students.
    - Student demonstrates evidence of positive leadership and contribution in the classroom, school, church, and community.
  - **Business & Technology:**
    - Student demonstrates evidence of having a passion for the business or technology field.
    - Student demonstrates evidence of positive leadership and contribution in the classroom, school, church, and community.
