Students applying for this scholarship must:

- Complete the application including the short essay section (with assistance of parent for younger elementary students) and submit to the LCS Main Office by April 15, 2019
- Request a teacher to do a teacher recommendation by April 15, 2019

Students will be notified by May 15 regarding their Scholarship award.
