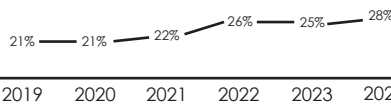

Total Percent of Students Taking AP Classes



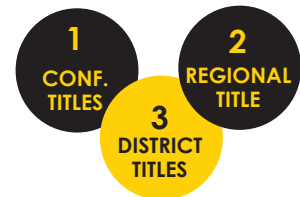

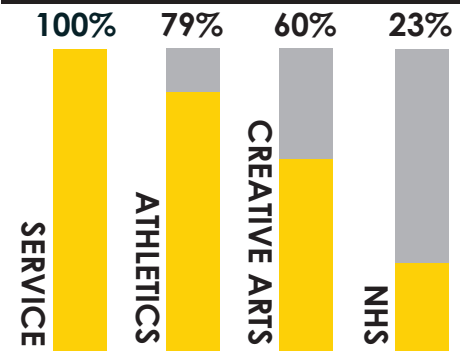

Lansing Christian School was established in 1951 by a group of families who had a vision for a preschool-12 Christian school that would be vigorously academic and thoroughly Christian. LCS is a day school with grades preschool to 12. The community includes 577 students and 48 faculty. The small student to teacher ratio allows for caring and positive working relationships with teachers. The school operates with preschool, elementary, middle and high school on a single secure campus. Our students come from more than 90 different churches and 20 public school districts.
