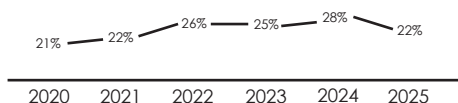

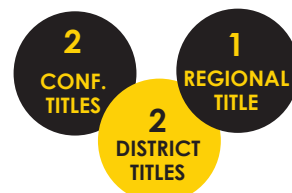
Total Percent of Students Taking AP Classes



100% Percent of students who earned score of 3 or higher on AP test (Spring 2025)



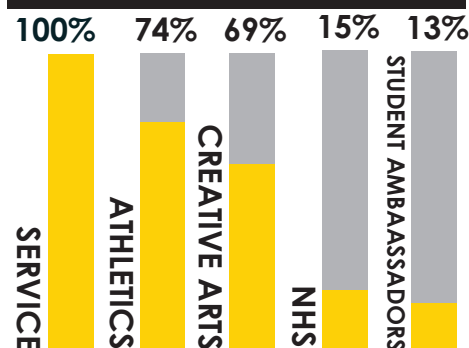
