

High School Retreat 2019
RULES AND EXPECTATIONS

1. Participate appropriately:

a. **Bring your Bible and a pen or pencil to every Chapel**

b. Know where you need to be and when you need to be there

2. Follow the rules:

a. Obey all adults whether from LCS or Camp Geneva

b. Between 10:45 and 11:00 p.m., you must be getting ready for bed

c. You must be in your cabin between 11:00 p.m. and 6:00 a.m. unless your chaperone has given you permission to go to the nurse

d. NEVER enter into cabins of students of the opposite gender

e. Do not chew gum

f. The possession and/or use of alcoholic beverages, tobacco, and other controlled substances is strictly prohibited

g. No music players, cell phones, or other electronic devices. Phones and other electronic devices may be used on the bus. Cell phones and electronic devices used without permission on Retreat may be confiscated.

h. Long boards and skateboards are prohibited

i. Hats may not be worn in the chapel

J. Hammocks are welcome at Camp Geneva, but only in certain areas.

These areas are:

The small cluster of trees by the beach landing (near the chapel), and the small cluster of trees between the chapel and the first Michigan cabin. Hammocks may be stacked two high and be no more than 10 ft. off the ground. Two people of the same gender may share a hammock. Hammocks are NOT permitted anywhere else.

3. Be aware of safety:

a. Remain within the bounds of the camp at all times unless accompanied by an adult

b. The beach and lake are off limits without an adult present and supervising

c. No swimming unless a lifeguard is present

4. Food service:

a. BE PROMPT to all meals. This is required so food can be served at its best and so that you are there for important announcements and the blessing

b. You are responsible for taking care of your own table service and eating area

c. One class is assigned to clean up the eating area after each of the meals. Check the schedule to see when your class is assigned

5. Facility:

a. Bring your own sleeping bags or blankets as well as towels and soap

b. Students must follow their cabin assignments and are NOT permitted to switch cabins. You are NOT allowed to move bunks or mattresses.

c. Conserve energy: turn out lights upon leaving the cabin and only let the chaperone change the thermostat

d. Only use the facilities assigned to us

e. Make an effort to pick up after yourself so we leave the facility in better condition than when we arrived

f. All trash in cabins should be put into trash bins. Please do not make a mess with snacks. The cabins have carpet and food attracts bugs.

6. Consequences: Anyone who violates any of these rules may be sent home
