Lansing Christian was first accredited by the Michigan Association of Non-Public Schools (MANS) in 1996. In 2007 the School was accredited by the North Central Association (NCA).

In 2012, and in 2016, Advanced Ed (formerly known as the North Central Association), in partnership with Christian Schools International (CSI), awarded the school another five year accreditation. Lansing Christian is currently in process to earn an additional five year accreditation from CSI through 2027.

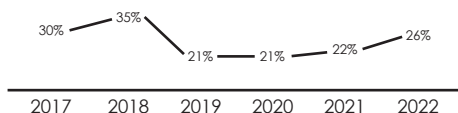

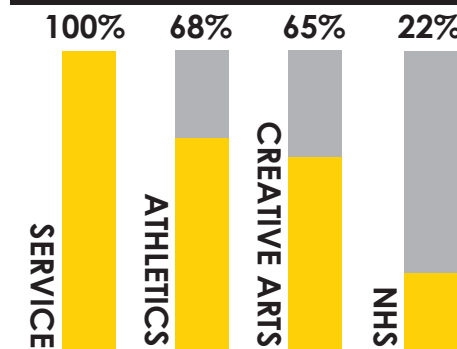

Lansing Christian School was established in 1951 by a group of families who had a vision for a preschool-12 Christian school that would be vigorously academic and thoroughly Christian. LCS is a day school with grades preschool to 12. The community includes 590 students and 49 faculty. The small student to teacher ratio allows for caring and positive working relationships with teachers. The school operates with preschool, elementary, middle and high school on a single secure campus. Our students come from more than 70 different churches and 20 public school districts.
