All of the money raised at the event goes to the LCS Annual Fund which supports every part of the Christian education we provide at Lansing Christian School including innovative programs and our amazing teachers. Gifts to the Annual Fund also help to reduce the cost of tuition for all students, making a quality Christ-centered education accessible to more families in the Greater Lansing area.
